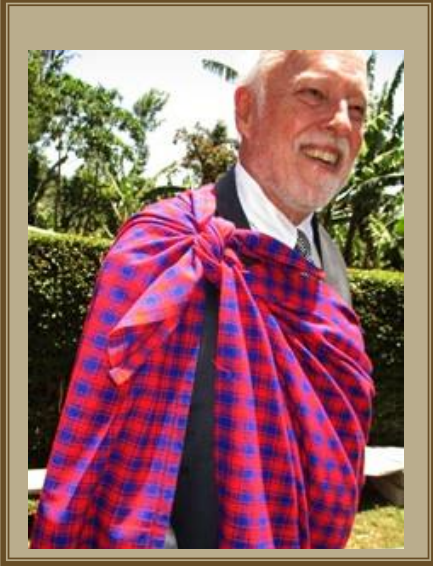

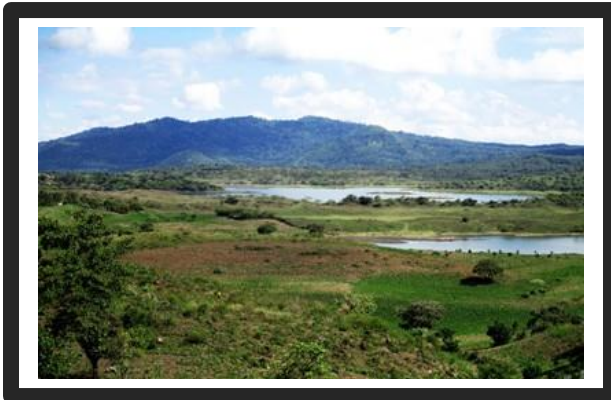

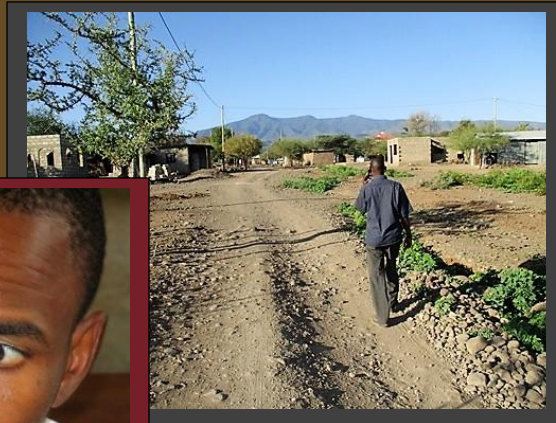


Kwanikoli EAGT

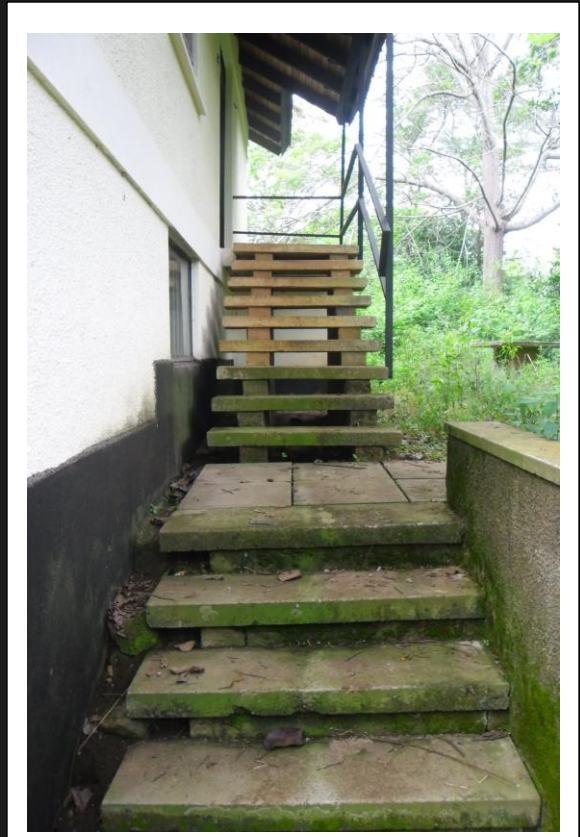


Rain. Rain. Rain.
